Hannah's House Student Centre,

The education is one of most needed in Cambodia to rebuild its broken nation. We thank God for all the blessings to the young people of Cambodia via Hannah's House Student Centre. Since 2008 to now there has been eight teen girls that have come to stay and study under the support of Hannah's House Student Center, twelve of them are university students and six of them are learning life skill. Five of the twelve of university students have finished their studies and four are getting the job. Also six of those life skill learners, four have finished their studies and two of them got a job.



At the same time, as we operate Hannah's House Student Center, we also support three others, the boy studying in university, two in universities in Phnom Penh, one in university in Prey Veng province, and four boys in middle school at Stung Trong. Because we have put in our hearts to help these young people and the need is so great now, that Family For Mission is going to establish another student centre soon called, "Gideon's House Student Centre" for male students. For this new project, we will
