

Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ,

We have just spent an amazing 10 days with Mick Norsa teachers and students from NBCS School Sydney Australia, who join Mission Cambodia and Family for Mission every year at this time. This year the flooding was the biggest in a decade. It has decimated many communities, with the loss of life, homes, livestock and crops. Across Cambodia 141 people have died. In the midst of this tragedy, the LORD has opened the door again to Trea Commune, which has been shut for a number of years. Due to the flooding, we had a request for rice for families affected by the flood as well as a request to build a house. The house being for a woman with 5 children living on a small boat. Trea Commune received 60 x 25kg bags of rice that was from NBCS given out from small boats. Following the rice drop, we got into 2 smaller boats for a tour of the flooded village. The main street through the commune covered with water, the only traffic being boats.



The team spent 4 days in Stung Trong, doing three major rice drops giving out 11 ton and visiting different villages to feed the children. This was after a trip to Kampong Somme with the orphans for a day at the beach. AS well as teaching in the Hard Word English School in StungTrong. Another highlight was the boat trip up the Mekong from Kampong Cham.

We are now an official Local NGO Family for Mission headed up by Sarun, so you can stay in touch by going to <http://afamilyformission.blogspot.com> As we have been setting up Family For Mission, going over the accounts. It is amazing by what the LORD has done through Mission Cambodia and now Family for Mission. Since 2003, we have built 36 houses and from 2007 have given 120 tons of rice to the poor. How great is our God.

There are the Churches; Stung Trong the mother church, then

Preah Church, 4 house churches and outreaching in 2 other villages. Boeung Kat has 5 house churches and another village outreach where they have one family that believes. In Phnom Penh we have Hannah's House and Gideon House for both young men and young women students. There are 13 female students and 6 male students. We have Hannah's house church.

Another miracle was meeting the District Governor of Stung Trong District. Stung Trong District has a population of 118,000 people and we had the privilege of presenting to the Governor 20 rubber garbage bins for



the promenade along the river at Stung Trong. Mr Kimlean the Commune leader was also part of the official dignitaries at the presentation.

I would like to thank every one of you for your prayers, love, encouragement, faith and financial support, we are all in this together as we see His kingdom come and the gospel go to the Laos border. Thank you, the LORD bless you all.
